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National Workshop on Research Methodology at RMD Engineering College



A two day, National Workshop on Research Methodology was held during 27-28, Jan 2012. It was organized by the Dept. of Computer Science & Engineering, RMD Engineering College in association with the IEEE Computer Society, IEEE Professional Communication Society, CSI Div IV & Chennai Chapter and the ISTE Local Chapter. The programme was inaugurated by Dr. K. Chandrasekaran, Dean, RMK Engineering College and Syndicate Member of Anna University, Chennai and the Chairman of IEEE CS & PCS Mr. H.R Mohan. Dr. K. Sivaram presided over the inaugural session. Dr. R. M. Suresh welcomed the participants and provided

an overview of the programme. Dr. K. Dinakaran proposed vote of thanks after the formal inauguration of the workshop.

Dr. Chandrasekaran, in his Inaugural address said that the Research Methodology is the subject of interest as on date to everyone. He stressed that one need to go through in a methodical way to achieve better research and performance. Mr. Mohan, highlighted the role of professional societies like IEEE, CSI & ACM for professional development and the support they extend in research activities through their peer reviewed technical journals, archived digital libraries and conferences. He added that the researchers should avoid plagiarism and ensure

their originality in research work. He appreciated the interests of delegates come from both academic and industry streams.

Dr. R. M. Suresh, Associate Dean for Research at RMD Engineering College was the key resource person on both the days of the workshop. The 10 workshop sessions were well planned and covered major topics in Research Methodology such as: How to choose a research problem; How to write papers, Tools available for the research, Data sets, Journals to publish the research papers, How to organize thesis, Funding Agencies, and How to control plagiarism etc., The workshop attracted 75 delegates from various parts of South India including from NIT Surathkal, JNTU Hyderabad and Pondicherry University, Puducherry & Trivandrum University. The participants provided a very good feedback on the workshop and considered that this workshop was like a condensed M.Phil degree in two days. The participants were given the workshop and reference materials (of about 500 MB) such as whitepapers, tutorials, open source software in a USB drive.
